



Full Text


Not all articles in PubMed are in full text. You can use filters so only full text articles are returned.



Permalinks

If PubMed Central has the full text of the article, you can use the URL in the address bar as the permalink.

If PubMed links to EBSCO for the full text of the article, use the EBSCO permalink available from the "Tools menu on the right side of the page.





Citations

All the information for a citation is provided in PubMed but the information is not given in a specific citation style.

If the article directs you to the article in EBSCO, all EBSCO resources have a citation feature available from "Tools" menu on the right side of the page.


