




BadgerLink provides full text access to Consumer Reports from January 1991 to present. Articles are available in HTML and PDF full text. HTML Full Text PDF Full Text



Permalinks

A Permalink is a persistent URL that points to an article or video within a BadgerLink resource.

The permalink for an article can be found in the Tools on the right side of the detailed records page. Click on the permalink icon and copy the URL that pops up.


A citation for an article, image, or video can be found in the Tools on the right side of the detailed records page. Click on the Cite icon and the citation in a variety of formats pops up.
