Academic Search Premier is a multidisciplinary database of academic journals for scholarly research. This full-text database has over 2,000 active full-text, non-open access journals, most peer-reviewed and more than 75,000 videos from the Associated Press, updated monthly.

Education Source is an education research database with full-text journals covering all levels from early childhood to higher education. This full-text database has unique full-text journals not available in Academic Search Premier, over 3,700 education-related conference papers and more than 550 full-text books.

ERIC is an authoritative database of citations and full-text education literature and resources. This database has more than 1.6 million records and links to nearly 750,000 full-text documents, including journal articles, books, conference papers, curriculum guides, dissertations, and policy papers.
