


- Go back to the record:** Arrow icon in the top left corner.
- Download or email image:** SAVE button in the top right corner.
- Show detailed information:** Magnifying glass icon on the right side.
- Viewer options:** Vertical toolbar on the right side.
- Change size of image:** Plus and minus icons in the vertical toolbar.
- Search terms highlighted:** Red boxes highlighting names like 'Hallett' and 'Otis' in the census table.
- Show filmstrip of scanned pages of this document:** Filmstrip icon at the bottom left.
- Show transcription of highlighted lines:** Transcription icon at the bottom right.
